Pima County Code Revisions to

**Chapter 17.04 - General Provisions, 17.12 – Permits and Permit Revisions and 17.16
Emission limiting standards**

The Pima County Department of Environmental Quality (PDEQ) has submitted a "Notice of Proposed Rulemaking," to the Arizona Administrative Register for publication on September 21, 2007. PDEQ is proposing revisions to the County's Air Quality regulations (Title 17 of the Pima County Code). The proposed Air Quality revisions amend Chapter 17.04.340, 17.12.190, 17.12.400, 17.12.510 and new section 17.12.520 - fees related to individual and general air quality permits.
