

2020 CANDIDATE FILING PROCEDURES FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT CANDIDATES

School District candidates file their **petitions** with the **Pima County School Superintendent's Office**, which can be reached at 520-724-8451. Petitions and other information are available on their website: www.schools.pima.gov/elections

If a candidate receives contributions or makes expenditures, in any combination, of \$1200, the candidate must file a Statement of Organization with our office (Pima County Elections Department) to register as a candidate committee. A candidate that files this form will be required to file periodic campaign finance reports using the Pima County Campaign Finance Software. Information about the software is available on our website. There is an instruction sheet in this packet showing you where to go on our website to download the software.

The Arizona Secretary of State's Campaign Finance Handbook for Candidates lists the County School Superintendent as the filing officer for campaign finance reports for school district elections. However, the Pima County School Superintendent has assigned the Elections Department as the agent in charge of campaign finance filings for school district elections. **School District candidates file their Statements of Organization and campaign finance reports with the Pima County Elections Office.**
