

HOW TO CREATE A CASE STUDY

The Regional Flood Control District (RFCD) thanks you for your willingness to share your project and contribute to the spread of Low Impact Development/ Green Infrastructure (LID/ GI) sustainable design.

STEP 1

Use the “Outline Guide to Create a Case Study” document as a guide for collecting all the useful information that will fully showcase your project.

STEP 2

Select the appropriate template based on the development use of your project. Occasionally a project can fall under two categories and we will be happy to transfer the information to the second template for you.

STEP 3a

If you wish, please fill in the template. Sometimes you have to be a little creative to make all the information fit, but usually there is a place for anything you believe is important. Use the existing Case Studies that are also on this web page as a guide.

STEP 3b

Or, if you would prefer, just send us the outline information and any pictures you have, and we can fill in the template for you. Once we are done with the draft, we will coordinate with you for any necessary modifications.
