## **This Class is for Ajo Residents Only**

**American Red Cross Lifeguard Training Classes will be offered by Pima County Staff for Ajo residents who intend to work for Pima County in the summer of 2016.** Material covered will include American Red Cross Lifeguard Training. **Fee:** \$50.00 Participants must be at least 15 years old to take the class ( must be 16 years old by May 1, 2016 to work for Pima County). There is a pre-requisite swim of 300 yards continuously (using breaststroke and freestyle), treading water for 2 minutes without the use of arms, and a 10 pound brick retrieval so please be prepared. **The class fee is non-refundable once pre-requisites have been completed.** Class size is limited to the first 10 participants registered.
