REPORT COMMUNICABLE DISEASES

to the Local Health Department

-  Campylobacteriosis
-  Conjunctivitis: acute
-  Cryptosporidiosis
-  Diarrhea, nausea, or vomiting
-  Enterohemorrhagic *Escherichia coli*
-  *Haemophilus influenzae*: invasive disease
-  Hepatitis A
-  Measles
-  Meningococcal invasive disease
-  Mumps
-  Pertussis (whooping cough)
-  Rubella (German measles)
-  Salmonellosis
-  Scabies
-  Shigellosis
-  Streptococcal Group A infection
-  Varicella (chicken pox)

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-  Submit a report within 24 hours after detecting a case or suspect case
 -  Submit a report within 24 hours after detecting an outbreak.
 -  Submit a report within five working days after detecting a case or suspect case.
