RESOLUTION  
April 12, 2013

WHEREAS, the Pima County Workforce Investment Board (WIB) was established by the federal Workforce Investment Act of 1998 and appointed by the Pima County Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the WIB believes that a trained and educated workforce is critical to the economic health of our region; and

WHEREAS, the WIB has adopted a Sector Strategy to promote targeted workforce investment in sectors of strategic importance to the regional economy; and

WHEREAS science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) skills have been identified as a significant workforce need in our targeted sectors; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Legislature has made significant cuts to state subsidies for public post-secondary and adult education, dramatically reducing the number of workers Pima County is able to train for the local labor market;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Pima County Workforce Investment Board recommends that the State approve House Bill 2265 to fund post-secondary education in science, technology, engineering and math skills (STEM).
